To the qualified electors of Jackson County, State of Michigan, of the City of Jackson, Blackman Charter, Columbia, Concord, Grass Lake Charter, Hanover, Henrietta, Leoni, Liberty, Napoleon, Norvell, Parma, Pulaski, Rives, Sandstone Charter, Spring Arbor, Springport, Summit, Tompkins, and Waterloo Townships, notice is hereby given that a General Election will be held for the purpose of electing candidates for the following: President and Vice-President of the United States, United States Senator, Representative in Congress, Representative in State Legislature, State Board of Education, University of Michigan, Michigan State University, Wayne State University, County offices of Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff, Clerk and Register of Deeds, Treasurer, Drain Commissioner, Surveyor, County Commissioner, township offices of Supervisor, Treasurer, Clerk, and Trustees, Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, Circuit Court, Probate Court, District Court, Community College, School Board, and village offices of President, Clerk, Treasurer, and Trustee.

COUNTY OF JACKSON
JAIL OPERATIONS MILLAGE QUESTION

For the purpose of funding ongoing operating expenses of the Jackson County Jail, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Jackson, Michigan be increased by up to 0.25 mills (\$0.25 per thousand dollars of state taxable valuation), for a period of ten (10) years (2024-2033) inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$1,516,970 in the first calendar year of the levy.

JACKSON COLLEGE MILLAGE PROPOSAL

0.1973 MILL FOR 10 YEARS TO RESTORE HEADLEE REDUCTION

LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the Jackson District Library, County of Jackson, be authorized to levy a millage annually in an amount not to exceed 1.7411 mills (\$1.7411 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the millage rate that expires in 2024, against all taxable property within the Jackson District

Library district for a period of eight (8) years, 2025 to 2032, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Jackson District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2025) if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library is approximately \$10,750,000. A portion of the revenue collected may be subject to capture by the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities of the City of Jackson, Blackman Charter Township, Leoni Township, Columbia Township, and Summit Township.

**BLACKMAN CHARTER TOWNSHIP
PUBLIC SAFETY MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in the Charter Township of Blackman, of 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) be renewed at the original voted 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2025 through 2029 inclusive, for the operations and equipment for the Township's Public Safety Department, raising an estimated \$1,285,505.45 in the first year the millage is levied?

**NAPOLEON TOWNSHIP
ROAD MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the Township of Napoleon be authorized to levy 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for 6 years for the purpose of providing funds for the rehabilitation of a portion of the local streets and roadways? Improvements would include rehabilitation of gravel local roads and rehabilitation of paved local roads within Napoleon Township in the tax years of 2024 – 2029. Funds will be collected and disbursed for improvements upon roads within Napoleon Township as the Township Board determines appropriate. This millage would result in a collection of an estimated \$424,992 in revenue in the first year the millage is levied.
